

## **TEACHER'S STRIKE "ACTION PLAN" FOR MOMS**

Here's a quick, easy idea of something to keep the kids busy while they are at home, during the teachers strike. Using materials you can find around the home you can make this fun door sign.



### **WHAT YOU NEED:**

- An old cardboard box, either a cereal box or beer box.
- Scraps of everyday cardboard or fun foam.
- Paints
- Old magazines or stickers
- A piece of string or wool
- Sequins and glitter glues(optional)

### **WHAT TO DO:**

- Cut a rectangle from the cardboard box, about 13cm x 15cm in size.
- Paint the front and edges using the paints which you have.
- Cut wording for the sign out of coloured card or fun foam.
- Cut pictures out of old magazines or use stickers to add some life.
- Arrange your wording and pictures on your dry board, then glue down.
- Use glitter glues and sequin (if you have) to decorate.
- Make two holes at the top of the board to thread the string through, and tie.
- Hang on your door

**Use your imagination to make any sign you want and HAVE FUN!!!**
